Whereas: Four thousand eight hundred and ninety four (4894) years ago, King

Hung Vuong established the country which is known today as Vietnam;

Whereas: The social and cultural contributions of many Vietnamese-Americans to

the City of Boston and the United States are many and noteworthy; and

Whereas: In the mid-13th century (1257) General Tran Hung Dao, with unique

talents in military strategy, defeated the Mongol invasion of Vietnam three times. The world community has objectively acknowledged that those great victories over the Mongols, had a profound impact on human

Whereas: In February of 1984, General Tran Hung Dao was unanimously selected

by the British Royal Society as one of the greatest generals of all time;
